KNOW WHEN TO STOP. PROTECT OUR KIDS.

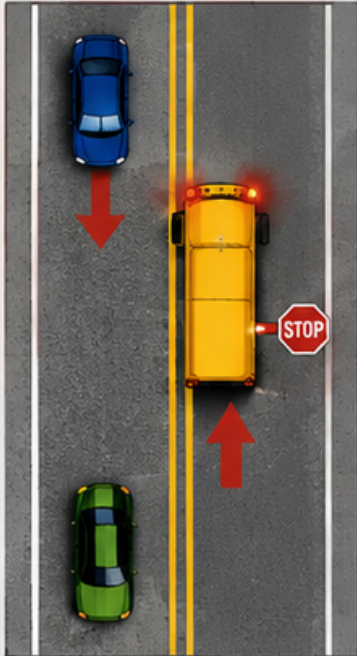


YOU MUST STOP

When approaching a stopped school bus with red lights flashing and stop arm extended.

TWO-LANE ROAD

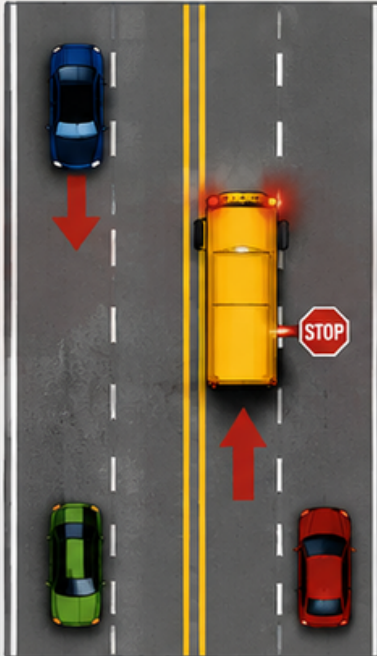
Vehicles traveling in both directions **MUST STOP.**



Both directions must stop.

FOUR-LANE ROAD WITH NO MEDIAN

Vehicles traveling in both directions **MUST STOP.**



Both directions must stop.

ROAD WITH CENTER TURN LANE

Vehicles traveling in both directions **MUST STOP.**



Both directions must stop.

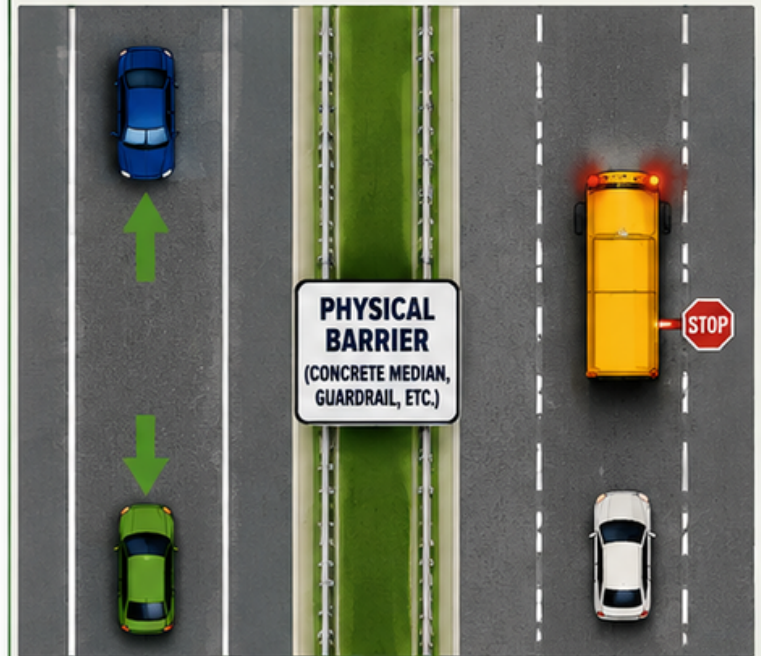


YOU DO NOT HAVE TO STOP

When the bus is on the opposite side of a divided roadway with a physical barrier.

DIVIDED HIGHWAY

Vehicles traveling in the opposite direction **DO NOT** have to stop.



Opposite direction traffic may proceed without stopping.



FLASHING YELLOW LIGHTS MEAN THE BUS IS PREPARING TO STOP.
FLASHING RED LIGHTS AND EXTENDED STOP ARM MEAN STOP.
